Surveyed for Andrew Baskin, Lancelot Brown, Jonathan Weaver & Jacob Hart the Town of Belfast as represented in the above Plat - The above plat is laid down from a scale of 10 poles to an inch, all the lots on the West side of main street were laid out by Andrew Baskin except lots nos. 19 & 20, which were laid out by Jacob Hart, all the lots on the East side of main street were laid off by Lancelot Brown except a part of lot No. 7 & lots No. 8, 9 & 10 were laid off by Jonathan Weaver, lot No. 1 is 7 1/2 poles square, lots No. 2, 3, 19 & 20 are 3 poles in front & 7 1/2 back, lot No. 18 is 4 in front & 6 poles back, lot No. 29 is 4 poles & 14 links in front & 7 1/2 poles back, all the balance are 4 poles in front & 7 1/2 poles back, main street is 4 poles & 8 links wide & runs N. 10° W. & S. 10° E. Cross street east ~~side~~ of main is 4 poles wide & runs S. 79° E. west ~~side~~ of main on north side runs S. 70° E. south side S. 79° E. west end of Cross street is 3 1/2 poles wide, stones are planted as shown on plat - alleys one pole wide.
